OTTAWA, Jan. 15.—Gen. Sir Wm.
Otter has found it necessary to go
to Fort William and Port Arthur to
deal with the allen enemy situation,
which has become very serious. No
less than 1.400 allens have been regis-

less than 1,400 aliens have been registered in the twin cities, most of whom will be interned. The problem confronting the authorities is to provide work for them, more particularly as

is considered undestrable to have them compete with Canadian labor. A number of the aliens will probably be sent to clear the experimental farm in

North Ontario. Others will be sent to a camp to be established in the west. General Otter will return to Ottawa, but later expects to make a trip

through to the Pacific coast.
