sequence, interned at Lethbridge for the balance of the war. At the time of making registration the mon was only given a parole card, not having declaimed his intention of leaving the country. This should be a warning to others of similar nationality that

they cannot be allowed to leave Canada except under special dispensation, and that the parole card issued by the registrar are only for use in the Dcminion.
