

WOULD GUARD BOUNDARY

Officers Suggest Co-operative Guarding of U.S. Boundary.

Vancouver, B.C., Jan. 25.—Major W. Tait and Col. F. B. Gregory, of the Canadian National Reserve, will meet Major-General Sam Hughes, Minister of Militia, in Victoria to-day and lay before him a plan for guarding the boundary line between Canada and the United States with men of the reserve force. The officers will suggest that the men of the reserve be placed at short intervals along the frontier to act in co-operation with the United States officials not only in keeping out any war-made German, but also in seeing that ~~German reservists~~ in Canada do not go into the United States.
