

# FIFTY-SIX BELOW AT WHITE RIVER.

## Intensely Cold Weather is Now Spreading Over Ontario

---

### ZERO IN TORONTO TO-NIGHT

---

### Arctic Conditions Prevail in Cochrane and Port Arthur Districts

---

The mercury has started on the predicted tumble in Toronto and to-night it will be cavorting around the zero mark, according to Oracle in Queen's Park. Intensely cold weather which prevails in New Ontario and the west is arriving in large quantities in the older portions of the Province to-day. At noon the registration here was 14 degrees above zero with the going down sign out. The severe conditions will continue all day to-morrow and there is nothing in sight to give hope of escaping a decidedly chilly week end.

#### Where It Is Cold.

But how would you like to live at White River, Ontario? Fancy 56 degrees below zero and then try to forget it. That was how the mercury was playing around the boots of the thermometer in that unpopular winter resort early this morning. It moved up to 52 below later in the day but the weather was still quite cold enough.

Port Arthur, too, can lay claim to another cold day. It is 34 degrees below there. Cochrane, Ont., is worrying along with 36 below and 16 below is the score at Sault Ste Marie. All points along the Lakes have North Pole symptoms to-day with no signs of abatement.

#### Manitoba Very Cold.

On the Pacific Coast there is no frost, the temperature at Victoria being 38 degrees above zero, but coming East there is much cold. Zero temperatures prevail in Alberta and Saskatchewan. Manitoba continues very cold with temperatures ranging from 20 to 30 degrees below zero. It was 28 below in Winnipeg during the night.

Down East as far as the Atlantic Coast they are in for a dose of gales and snow with much colder weather.
