

DOMINION POLICE FORCE IS DOUBLED SINCE WAR BEGAN

More Careful Guarding of Par- liament Buildings Requires More Men

OTTAWA, Feb. 11.—The Dominion police force has been more than doubled since the outbreak of the war owing to the exigencies of more careful guarding of the parliament buildings at Ottawa and the requirements of the secret service. There are now 382 men on the Dominion police force as compared with 119 in July last. The cost of the service to the country is now about \$25,000 per month.
