Mazur Acquitted On Second Charge But is Held Pending Inquiry by Registrar of

Aliens

Paul Maxur appeared again before Chief Justice Sir William Mulock this morning on the charge preferred against him by the Orand

Jury, that of high treason. He has been acquitted on, the other charge of conspiring to sommit high treason.

The evidence at the trial was admitted by the Crown, and the verdict of not guilty was assented to.

Maxur was then semoved to the cells, being held under authority of the Registrar of Allen Enemies to be taken under military escort to be questioned by the Registrar. Since the trial revealed the fact that Maxur, who claimed to be a

Canadian, is really an Austrian, his freedom or internment is at the discretion of the Registrar.
