

Want Internment Of Some Aldermen

British Imperial Association Feels Aggrieved at Use of Alien Labor.

"Resolved, that the aldermen who recently advocated the employment of alien labor on the North Toronto sewer should be interned as enemies of the King; as by this means we, the B. I. A., believe that said aldermen are indirectly aiding aliens by allowing money to go out of the country while the manhood of our country is being sapped by reason of unemployment caused by the said alien labor."

The preceding is the form of a resolution drawn up at the meeting of the Marlscourt branch of the British Imperial Association last night in Little's Hall. It was decided to send a letter to the Board of Control regarding complaints that the work of the city was not being fairly distributed.
