

# Full Fledged German Count Sojourns Here

A full-fledged German Count, decorated with moncele, cane, and upturned war points, the only real live specimen of "kultured" German nobility in captivity in Canada, is one of the latest arrivals at Fort McNicol, where the prisoners of war garnered in since the declaration of hostilities abide in peace and plenty, awaiting the judgment day.

Five German army officers, including the "Count," were received at the detention camp yesterday, having been brought down by the Mounted Police from Calgary. Major Stewart refused to divulge the names of the captives, owing to their former "social position," but it is understood that some of them were members of the Hussar colony.

General Sir William Otter, chief interment officer for the Dominion, is expected in the city next week. Latest advices say that Major-General Steele will not visit Lethbridge.
