

KEEP-TAB ON ALIENS

IMMIGRATION AGENTS ARE KEPT
VERY BUSY.

A Great Many Have To Be Looked
After In Kingston Theatrical Cir-
cles—They are Followed Until
They Leave Canada.

Keeping track of aliens is a duty resting on the immigration department, and it keeps the officials all over Canada on the alert to carry out their part.

The theatrical business calls for a great deal of attention from the immigration officials, owing to the fact that there are so many aliens following this profession. The department keeps tab on all of them, and this necessitates a great deal of work. It is up to the agents to see that the parties leave Canada and it is their duty to accompany them to the border line.

Just now, a number are filling engagements at Kingston theatres, and immigration agents have instructions to keep track of them.

It may not be generally known, but the manager of every show coming to Canada is called upon to submit to the immigration department at Ottawa the names of every alien in his company, together with a list of the places they are to play in Canada, with the dates. By this information, the department is able to have the agents at the various centres posted.

Naturally, the people in the theatrical business do not take very kindly to the system, but it is something they have to stand for, although sometimes it puts them to a great deal of inconvenience and worry.

Quite a number of aliens land in Kingston, in connection with the theatrical business, and the local immigration agents are receiving messages from headquarters regarding their movements from time to time.
