

Prison Camps In Germany Open For View

Berlin (via The Hague), March 30.
—Germany has agreed to throw open her military prison camps for an inspection by a United States commission. Ambassador Gerard made this announcement to-day. Britain is understood to have accepted the same offer and trips of inspection are to begin immediately. Ten Americans will constitute the commission, under the terms of the agreement. The commission will be permitted to make a thorough inspection of every prison camp in Germany and Britain.
