

Three German prisoners made their escape last week from the local interment prison. One of them appears to have got away on Thursday night, and two others the following morning. It is thought that the first man, who is said to have been an old employee of the C. P. R. dining car service, succeeded in making his way to Sicamous, where he probably boarded a train for the east at that point. The other two started off in a southerly direction, but being without funds or provisions were easily rounded up before they got further away than Westbank, and were returned to "durance vile" on Saturday night.
