

# GERMAN GOES TO JAIL

**Albert Schmidt, Trouble Maker, Carried a Revolver.**

Albert Schmidt, a German, was sentenced to two months in jail in the police court yesterday morning after he had been convicted on a charge of carrying a revolver. He was arrested by a constable on beat duty in a down town hotel after he had been cowing several of the patrons of the bar with the weapon. The manager of the hotel called in the officer, and Schmidt was subsequently taken to the police station in the patrol.

Investigations by the detective department found that the prisoner had been causing considerable trouble in Brandon, Man., because of his German excitations, and that he had been interned at that place for three months at the military concentration camp for alien enemies.
