Not German Agitator. The names of Albert Schmidt and Albert Smith led to confusion in the reports of a recent police court case. Albert Smith was arrested for carrying a revolver and was sentonced to two months in jull and it was stated in the press that he had caused trouble us a German ag -- tor. It is not true that the prisoner had been causing considerable trouble in Brandon because of German agitations, and it is not true that he had been interned at that place for three months at the military concentration camp for allen enciates. The Albert Smith orrested has been a naturalized British subject for many years, and has been in the omploy of the C. P. R. in Winnipeg for over 20 years at the stock yards here, and has never been convicted of any breach of the law. He was never in Brandon in his life, and is not an allen enemy nor has he been so re-

garded by anyono.
