The families who locate will nominally be prisoners until the close of the war, but the supervision over them will not be riskome, they are so distant from important centres that they could not easily run away, and could not possibly learn or communicate anything of service to the enemy. Now that they are taking a stake in the country they are regarded as perfeetly harmless. Several thousand cabins will be erected in the wilderness for these prischer pioneers. There is no fear but that their circumstances and their situation will assimilate them. and that they will become good Capadians. Hon. C. J.
