

WINNIPEG FIRE IS ATTRIBUTED TO ALIEN ENEMY

WINNIPEG, April 21.—Lieut.-Col. Pucharme, commander of the fifth artillery brigade, held an investigation this afternoon of the early morning fire which destroyed the racing stables at the exhibition grounds, in which 40 sick horses belonging to the brigade were sheltered. This report will be turned in to headquarters tomorrow morning and will not be made public until it has been considered there.

Those who are acquainted with the details of the conflagration feel that it has been of incendiary origin and most of the police and military authorities believe that an alien enemy was responsible.
