FOUR GERMANS ARRESTED. .. Prominent Vancouver Residents-Apparently Celebrating Advance Vancouver, B.C., April 29 .- Four prominent German residents of Vancouver were arrested today because the police belleve on Sunday night the quartette with a number of other compatriots engaged in a celebration of the German advance against Canadian troops at Ypres. It happened that the first and a very heavy casualty list of Vancouver men killed and wounded reached Vancouver Sunday night and it was an unlucky time for the Germans to select to celebrate anything. The Germans concerned declare they were merely having a housewarming, the party having been arranged several days previously. It is probable the four will be sent to a detention camp for allen enemies at Nanalmo. The men now detained are I'ani Koonf, capitalist; Baron von Luttowitz, a relative and intimate friend of the kaiser, Dr. Otto Grunert and Frederick Stritzel.
