

THIS GERMAN REJOICED OVER LUSITANIA'S FATE AND IS NOW INTERNED

Toronto, Ont., May 12.—For publicly rejoicing over the loss of the Lusitania, Paul Hoffman, Howard street, a lieutenant in the German army, was arrested by Detective Maurer on Saturday and interned.

Hoffman first came under suspicion when standing before a bulletin board, he remarked to the crowd that it was a great German victory, and only an indication of what his country was capable of doing. When he got home, he taunted his neighbors on the failure of the British navy to protect passenger vessels in British waters.
