ALL GERMANS WILL LIKELY BE INTERNED.

Premier Asquith Announced That British Government Has Matter Under Consideration.

LONDON, May 12-Lord Charles Beresford and William J. Hicks presented separate petitions in the House of Commons today asking that the House decree the interment of all male slien enemy of military age and the removal of other alien enemies to places thirty miles or more from London. The petition bore 4,000 signatures.

Premier Asquith stated in the House

of Commons today that the Cabinet was alive to the fact that "the progressive violation of the rules of civilized warfare and humanity by the enemy, culminating in the sinking of the Lusitania and the feelings thus probled, had made it necessary to look beyond merely military considerations. The Government therefore was carefully considering the practicability of the segregation and interment of alien

enemies on a more comprehensive

scale."
