

POSE AS MACEDONIANS TO GET OUT OF CANADA

GERMANS FIND SCHEME UNSUCCESSFUL,—NO TICKETS WITH REGISTRAR'S PERMIT.

Another batch of aliens applied for permits yesterday, but in all cases they were refused. One German protested that he was not in sympathy with German methods of warfare. Mr. Snow replied: "Well, we want all good Germans to remain in the country, and so long as you behave yourself you will not be molested."
