

UNEMPLOYED AUSTRIANS ARE LEAVING CANADA

Three Thousand of Them on Their Way To Enter The United States.

Winnipeg, May 17.—The advance guard of the Austrian army of the unemployed making for the United States reached Otterburne yesterday. This is about half-way to the United States border. The main body is about five miles behind. They are expected to reach Emerson to-night.

Soldiers of Canada and immigration officers of the United States are mingling with them in an unsuccessful attempt to get them to turn back.

Another body of more than a thousand Austrians are finishing preparations to start for the States late yesterday afternoon.

Canadian officials vigorously denied that they had instigated the Austrians to leave Canada in order to solve a situation that was admittedly bothering them.
