FIND HAVEN AT EMERSON. Remnant of Unemployed Austrian Army Belag Cared For. Emerson, Man, May 19.—Two hundred Austrians, the remnant of the army of unemployed, numbering one

thousand, which left Winnipeg last Friday bound for the United States, have found a temporary haven here, where they are being fed and housed comfortably, and as a result have signified their intention of making no immediate effort to cross the border.

So far they are orderly. They were notified yesterday by United Stries immigration officials that they would not be permitted to cross the international line. Mayor Gasselman, of Emerson, has renewed a request that Canadian millitary authorities take charge of the men, who are subject to interna-
