After the arrival of the special train of five ceaches which took Major McLeod and his troop down to Emerson, and brought the Austrians back, part of the 45th Battalion acted as rescort through the city streets, and in this way not one man was able to escape. None apparently wished to escape, for when at Emerson they were told by an interpreter that at the e d of the journey they would be fed regularly, they became docile enough and did as they were told.
