Austrians.

Ottawa, May 15.—While the Canadian authorities have bilderto eserties with those individuals of German
and other snemy origin who have
aboven a disposition to behave them-

selves, there are indications of an early tightening up.

The Lusitania horror has brought insistent demands from every part of the country that Germans; irrespective of behavious and regardless of whether recently naturalized or not shall at once be taken in band and registered or interned.

People Are Worked Up.
This, of course, may be an extreme yiew of the situation, but news of the celebration of the sinking of the great liner in German clubs in various Canadian cities, of the ringing of joy bells in German communities, and of

rejoicing in the German settlements of the west has come to the attention of the authorities and an investigation will follow which may lead to the placing in concentration camps a goodly number of those who have been enjoying freedom.

N. Neturalisations.

Meantime there is an increased inclination on the part of unnaturalized German's at large to seek speedy naturalization. It is not expected that their application will be granted in

any case.

The situation is practically acute on the Pacific Coast, where, as a result of jubiliations, 181 Germans in Vancouver and Victoria vicinity have been internied. There are now 43,000 alien enemies.

8,000 of whom are Germans, out on parole.
