

LONDON, ONT., HAS SCHEME TO PUT FOREIGNERS ON FARMS IN NEW ONTARIO

City Clerk Lett this morning received from the municipality of London, Ont., a copy of a resolution which that city is sending to all the municipalities in Ontario with a request that it be passed by the councils and forwarded to Premier Hearst. The resolution points out that there are in the towns and cities of Ontario many Russians, Roumanians, Italians, Austrians and other foreigners who stay in the cities because they have not the means to start farming. It is stated that they would make very desirable farmers, and the Government is requested at the next session of the legislature to pass an act providing farms in New Ontario for these people at nominal cost and the issuing of loans to them at a reasonable rate of interest to be repaid from the fourth to the eighth year of their occupation of their holdings.
