## SENT BOX OF EFFECTS . TO GERMAN CAPTAIN Calgary, May 21.—Fritz Thaden was

allowed out on his own recognizances of \$1.000 to keep the peace for two years when brought before the judge for sentence this morning, having

been convicted on a charge of aiding the enemy by sending a box of effects to one Von Wissman, a captain in the German army, who left the Hussar colony, where prisoner resided, last August and made his way to Germany. The fact that he had been in prison for four months, the judge stated, was more than a sufficient punishment for the offense for which he was convicted. Thaden was kept in custody and will be interned and sent to the detention camp at Lethbridge on this evening's train.
