PART 45TH BATTALION LEAVE SATURDAY FOR THE CAMP AT SEWELL

Reinforcements from Outside Points Arrive Today—Camp Advance Party Left Today

Major C. J. Whillier, Capt. Finn and about thirty-five men of the 45th Battalion left at eight o'clock this morning for Sewell camp. They are the advance party for the regiment, which will go into camp tomorrow morning. There was a good crowd at the C.P.R. depot to see the men entrain, it being recognized that their stay at Sewell may be a very brief one.

The men of the 45th Battalion who are not going as reinforcements or being kept here for guard over the aliens, will leave at eight o'clock Saturday morning. The local men number about 350, but this figure will be augmented by the units coming in from the outside points this afternoon. One hundred or more men will arrive from Souris at four o'clock and others will arrive at five o'clock. Some of the battalion will also arrive over the C.N.R.. When the men leave the exhibition grounds tomorrow they will be headed by their band and the march to the C.P.R. depot will start soon after seven o'clock.
