Employ Germans at Camp
It has been suggested that the
prisoners of war in Fort Henry be

paid the usual 25 cents a day and put at work doing duty around Barriefield camp, which is now done by the soldiers. Such work as building culverts, digging drains and

making ground repairs could be well done by the prisoners and the time now taken by the soldiers could be devoted to training. As the soldlers are paid \$1.10 a day it would be economy to employ the Germans.
