Mundheim has been under detention at the headquarters in Montreal of the interment officials since May 20, when he was arrested at the instance of a government official at Ottawa, it was said. He had been arrested shortly after the war started, but after an investigation was released. It is stated the second arrest followed an inquiry on the Isle of Orleans, a few miles below Quebec in the St. Lawrence. The cement company's plant is located there, and the island has been the subject of many rumors, chiefly concerning discovery of cement emplacements for heavy guns from which shells could easily be dropped into the citadel at Quebec.
