Montreal, June 7 .- The first and second class reservists of the Italian army, including the ten sub-classes of 1887 to 97, have been called to the colors from Canada. The orders came this morning in a cablegram from the Department of War at Rome to Chevaliere Gaultiers Chilesotti, consul-general for Italy. It is difficult to estimate the number of men included in these classes, as the Italians, unlike most other foreigners, are not obliged to register at their consulates upon arrival in Canada. However, there are probab-

ly between 15,000 and 20,000 men in Canada to-day who will leave.
