

GRAPKO MAY RECOVER

Alien Enemies Who Attempted to Escape Sentenced

Brandon, June 7.—The excitement caused by the break for liberty by fifteen Austrians has subsided almost as quickly as it arose. Andrew Grapko, the 18-year-old youth who was shot, has now a fighting chance for recovery, and the other injured man, Mike Butnya, aged 22, will probably leave the hospital this week. The rest of the men save the one who made a successful getaway were brought before Colonel Clark today. Two of the ringleaders, according to report, drew three months, five others two months, and several one month in the provincial jail. One alien, younger in years than the rest, was not jailed.

Col. Clark refuses to confirm or deny the sentences given above.
