ing on account of the miners going on strike, caused by the company not acceding to their demand that all Germans and Austrians be discharged immediately. Approximately only fifty men went on shift today, these including company officials and men who for the prevention of danger remain at work, and a few machinists. At seven o'clock not a digger or any other underground employee put in an appearance. The instructions from Victoria ordering the immediate internment of all unnaturalized allens were carried out expeditiously by the provincial police.
