

## **AUSTRIAN RESERVIST KILLED.**

**Tried To Cross Into The States At  
Niagara Falls.**

Niagara Falls, Ont., June 10.—While attempting to cross into United States at this point to return to his native land John Ryarczuk, 25 years of age, an **Austrian reservist**, was killed by a Grand Trunk engine at 11 o'clock last night in the local yards. His legs and arms were severed and head crushed. Two passports were found on him, one in Russian and one in Austrian. The Russian passport belonged to some other foreigner. He was to report in Rosinelaw, Austria, in 1915, and was to serve 12 years more in the army. Coroner McGarry will hold an inquest to-night.
