FALSE PRETENCES. Theodore Youritihuk, an Austrian,

who conducted an employment agency

in Craig street, was condemned yes-

terday by Judge St. Cyr to a fine of

\$100 and costs or three months in prison for obtaining money by false pretences. It was proven that the Austrian had obtained sums ranging from \$5 to \$25 from laborers, mostly Italians, to secure them employment at railway construction work. None of those who paid him money secured employment, and it was proven that Youritihuk had not any employment to give them. He was arrested by Inspector Rioux, of the Aliens Registrar's office. When he has served his three months at Bordeaux, unless he should pay his fine, the Austrian will be turned over to the military authorities to be interned.
