Three Austrians, who have no work and no prospect of obtaining it, expressed to the Registrar of Aliens on Tuesday, their desire to be interned. The men, who have up to a few weeks ago been employed here as laborers, are John Letik, 48 Nelson avenue, Bill Mazur, 334 Adelaide west, and John Horock, 28 Draper street. "Germans who have obtained naturalization papers and then start right in to abuse the privileges

right in to abuse the privileges granted them deserve the worst punishment," said Registrar Snow in confiscating the British naturalization papers of Ferdinand Ewert, who was found guilty of giving free vent to anti-British sentiments.

Indicative of the vigilance with which alien enemies are now being treated was the registrar's refusal to permit Ed. Bauriedell to go on a Sunday school picnic to Niagara Falls.
