

ALIEN ENEMIES RELEASED

Loss Handicapped Iron Works and They Are Returned

Guelph, Ont., June 18.—On May 15 some fifty Austrians and Hungarians were rounded up by the police and sent to Toronto, where they were interned. Eighteen of the men were employed at the International Malleable Iron Works. The management felt that the loss of the men would handicap the firm and place it under considerable expense to break in new men to the work. The company got into communication with Ottawa, with the result that the minister of justice ordered their release on the understanding that they return to Guelph and go to work. They arrived in the city yesterday and are again working for the company.
