

All Public Buildings Need To Be Watched

(Special to the Whig.)

Windsor, Ont., June 21.—The entire civil and military forces of Windsor and Walkerville were searching this section to-day for a woman and two men suspected of being German spy dynamiters who early to-day wrecked the plant of the Peabody Company of Walkerville and attempted to destroy the Windsor armories.

A suitcase containing twenty-six sticks of dynamite, connected with an alarm clock timed for 3.15 a.m., affords the slender clue to the identity of the bomb setters. This evidence was discovered under the east corner of the armory.

The police of all other Ontario cities are being warned to watch public buildings.
