cation for habeas corpus on behalf of several Austrians who objected last week to internment at Fernie was this morning mentioned before Mr. Justice Morrison and adjourned for a week on application of counsel for the attorney-general. It is learned from Fernie that the situation there is tense while awaiting the result of the habeas corpus proceedings here. Though the federal authorities have already taken over several hundred alien enemies and have placed them in internment camps, they apparently desire to discontinue the practice and are not so far agreeable to the attorney-gener-

al's request that all of the aliens shut out of the Fernie mines shall be sent to internment camps.
