AUSTRIANS GO TO CAMP Party of 50 Enemy Aliens

Leave Today for Valcartier Capt. Griffith, assistant to the Pro-

vost Marshal here, leaves this morn-

ing at 9.30 by the Canadian Northern, with a party of 50 Austrian enemy alien prisoners for Valcartier Camp. The Austrians are supplied with all necessities except a return ticket, and will spend the balance of the war period at Valcartier clearing additional land and doing other chores for the assistance of the Canadian forces. They will be under Major Rinfret, of the 87th, who is in command of His Majesty's Austrian forces for service at Valcartier, which now amount to upwards of 150 men. Very few Germans are now being interned. Four were sent a few days ago to Fort Henry at Kingston, and at present there is not a single German interned at the alien enemy prison on St. Antoine street. The work at the Enemy Alien Registration Bureau is going on smoothly under Mr. C. G. Ogden, the registrar, and prompt steps are taken to deal with any suspicious cases.
