London, June 22.—The cessation of racing has resulted in a scheme on the part of the Home Office to use the tracks for the internment of "alien enemies." Gatwick, situated in one of the most beautiful parts of Surrey, with a large grandstand and members' buildings and a plentiful water supply, is now being put in order for their reception. About 80,000 Germans, Austrians and Turks have been rounded up in London alone, but the task is not yet completed.
