Camp, Shot Dead By Canadian Scout

Austrian, Fleeing

MONTREAL-An Austrian, who escaped from Spirit Lake internment camp in northern Quebec, was shot and killed Sunday by a young man

named Germain, and three others who had escaped were captured by a posse organized at Amos, on the

Transcontinental line. Germain was taking provisions on a hand car from Lazarre to Amos, when he was stopped by the Austrian, who put his hand into his pocket as if to draw a revolver. Germain shot twice with a rifle he was carrying and the Austrian fell dead. The three other escaped prisoners

then attempted to attack him, but he speeded away from them to Amos, where the posse was organized that resulted in their arrest.
