

Markesfeldt Girl Sent to Mercer

Counsel Pleaded That She
Was Not a
Vagrant

Louisa Markesfeldt was today committed to the Mercer Reformatory for six months "and indefinitely." She will probably be sent on to the Industrial Reformatory.

Through Mr. T. J. O'Connor she argued that she was not a vagrant, for, said she, "I am able to work, I am willing to work, if I am given the opportunity I will work."

Magistrate Kingsford, in the Women's Court, answered that the Crown was going to give her the opportunity to work. She could work at the Mercer. He said he was acting in her best interests in sending her into detention for a while.

No new evidence in the case was brought.
