

2 German Spies, Bridge Wreckers, Have Been Interned

PORT ARTHUR, Ont., July 3—It is believed here that there is a connection between Gustoff Stevens and Karl Schmidt, who were arrested here as German spies some months ago, and the alleged plotting of German sympathizers at Detroit and Windsor.

When Stevens and Schmidt were on trial previous to being sent to prison for three months, each for having explosives on their persons while inspecting the C.P.R. bridge at Nipigon, they said they were supplied with funds by a Detroit man. The two prisoners' term for that offense has expired and they are now being sent to the internment camp at Kingston.
