

WAS HELD IN KINGSTON

Arrested As German Spy; Gunther Proves Identity.

Watertown, N.Y., July 10.—A. E. Gunther, former assemblyman of York, has arrived from Kingston, after having been brought before the Canadian Government authorities on suspicion of being a German spy. Mr. Gunther is of German type and upon his arrival in Kingston a few days ago, immediately became the object of suspicion by government officials. He was taken to headquarters and subjected to a lengthy cross-examination in which he finally succeeded in proving his identity.
