Must Stay in Camp.—'There is no foundation for the rumor which is boing industriously circulated in the north end of the city that the prisoners of war now interned at Brandon are to be released immediately. On the other hand the situation is such that increased accommodation has been made at the internment camp, The dispatch which appeared in yesreiday's papers, stating that a question had been asked in the British House of Commons as to the number of Germans and Austrians cmployed in munitions factories at Hamilton and Toronto, Ont., a leading citizen declared yesterday that he could find allen enemies employed in Winnipeg munitions works. and this matter will he investigated by the authoritles.
