ALIEN FOES MUST REPORT

Those Who Do Not Obey Rules Liable to Be Interned

Steps are being taken by the Regis-

trar of Enemy Aliens, Mr. C. G.

Ogden, K.C., to see that all those regis-

tered and allowed their freedom re-

port at the registry office on St. Antoine street regularly. Of late a number of these have been trying to dodge their weekly or daily reports, and during the past week 35 of them were rounded up, with a hint that if they disregarded regulations they might be interned. There are now 12,000 enemy aliens on the books at the registry office, a good many of whom have been interned. While the number of complaints has dropped off to about 15 daily, the number of alien enemies interned is not very great just now, since most of the men are working, and too busy to be troublesome.
