teen Austrians left the city Saturday on the C. P. R. for Brandon, under a strong military escort. They will be interned until the end of the war on account of having broken their parole or for inaking treasonable slatements. Among the number were the 11 men deported by the United States authorities, who are actively engaged in a general round-up of undestrables south of the border. The labor and political situations in the United States are responsible for the extraordinary precautions being taken to safeguard the public interests, and the authorities on both sides of the torder are co-operating with a view to certain eventualities.
