

# INTERNMENT CAMP WILL STAY HERE

Almost Depleted but 73  
Internes Still Remain  
With 34 Guards

---

There is no foundation for the stories about town that the internment camp here is to be permanently shifted to Calgary, although the camp has been so depleted during the past week or two, that a considerable loss of revenue to the city generally has resulted. Only 73 internes remain in the camp the remainder having been taken to Mount Castle to repair roads. They will, it is fully expected, be returned here in the fall, as the camp here is ideal and the city authorities have been generous with their terms of rental. Capt. Birnie, head of the camp, has no information as to any intention of removing the camp. He still has 34 guards on duty.
