## THIRTY-TWO ALIEN ENEMIES HAVE BEEN PAROLLED

Given Liberty on Account of Good Behavior and Have Secured Steady Work

## MUST REPORT REGULARLY

Gang of Aliens Under Guard, are Cleaning Up the Summer Fair Grounds

There have been thirty-two of the interned aliens paroled during the past few months, said Capt. Coleman this morning. Men who have had a good record and who are sure of steady period, like a year, are recommended to Ottawa and released on condition that they report regularly to a government official, such as police officer, justice of the peace or postmaster.
