

CANADA PLACES INTERNED ENEMY SHIP IN SERVICE

Ottawa, August 12.—The first German ship interned in a Canadian port has now been placed in the Canadian service, it was learned today. Its name, for obvious reasons, will not be announced, but it will shortly sail from a Canadian harbor under its new ownership.

Whether or not a new rule is to be inaugurated, and the scarcity of ocean tonnage relieved by the placing in service of more captured enemy vessels has not been announced.
