

GERMAN LEAVES KINGSTON.

Given Permission To Do So To Get
Work.

Claiming that he was unable to get work on account of being of German descent, although he has naturalization papers, Andrew Mueller, who was formerly employed at the Canadian Locomotive Works, has left the city. It is understood that he is in the United States.

Citizens became very suspicious about Mueller. It will be remembered that he was in Germany when war was declared, but, strange to say, he was allowed to leave his native land and return to Kingston.

When he returned he endeavored to get work in Kingston, but owing to coming from Germany there was evidently "nothing doing." He had lived in the city for some years, and had some property, some of which he sold before leaving.

Upon making enquiries at police headquarters on Tuesday morning, the Whig was informed that Mueller had shown his naturalization papers to the chief. When there were complaints to the police and military authorities about Mueller being a German, a search was made of his home, but absolutely nothing suspicious could be found. After the search was made Chief Bailie communicated with the authorities at Ottawa, who gave Mueller a permit to cross the border.
